We have had Miss Emma Hanvey working with us in Tullygally Primary School since August 2025 in a range of classes.

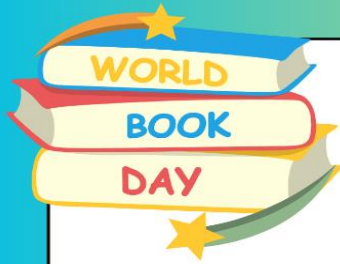
Miss Hanvey has now secured full time employment in another primary school and therefore next Monday will be her final day in Tullygally Primary School.

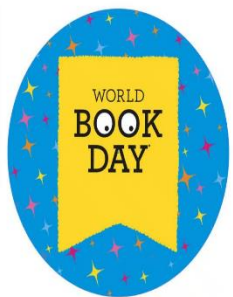
