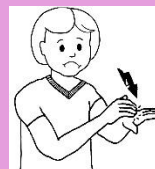

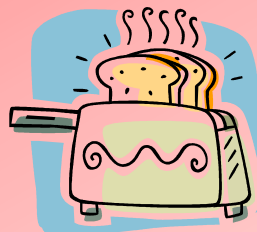

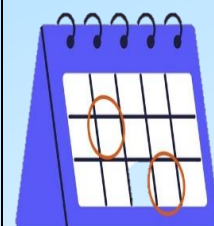

### Swimming

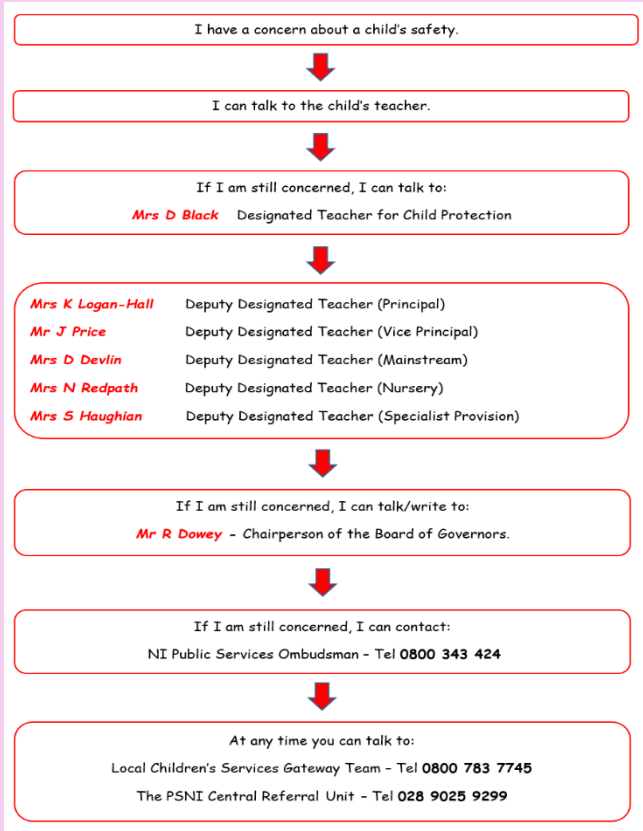

We have had a huge rise in pupil sickness across school over the past few weeks.

Even if guidance suggests that a child can attend school with particular illnesses, for example slapped cheek, please inform the class teacher at your earliest convenience to protect other vulnerable staff and pupils in school.
